DEFINITION

Displaced Homemaker (as defined in accordance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended 20 U.S.C. Section 1001 et seq. & Department of Education, Federal Register, Vol. 57, No. 158):

Displaced homemaker means an individual who –

- a. Is an adult, and
- b. Has worked as an adult primarily without remuneration to care for home and family, and for that reason has diminished marketable skills, and
- c.
 1. Has been dependent on public assistance or on the income of a relative but is no longer supported by that income;
 2. Is a parent whose youngest dependent child will become ineligible to receive assistance under Part A of Title IV of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 601), Aid to Families with Dependent Children, within two years of the parent's application for assistance under VATEA;
 3. Is unemployed or underemployed and is experiencing difficulty in obtaining or suitable employment as appropriate; or
 4. Is described in paragraphs (a) and (b) of this definition and is a criminal offender.
